E. CONDITIONS

According to the terms of the Haifa Outline
Town Planning Scheme and any additional and
amendments which were or may be made thereto
and also the following:-

Zones.

- a) Light Industrial Zone (coloured violet and
 edged dark violet).
- b) Commercial (coloured grey and edged dark
 violet).
- c) Residential Class "B" (coloured pale blue)
- d) Residential Class "C" (coloured yellow).

Road and Building Alignments.

The width of the roads and the mini-
mum distances between the Building Lines shall
be as shown on the plan. Corners of all
buildings and roads shall be rounded. Fences
on corners shall be on curves with a minimum
radius of 6 metres. Corners of buildings
without front set-backs shall be as shown on
the plan.

Building Restrictions.

No building permit shall be issued on
the North Western corner plot of the Neve
Shaanan Road & Haifa Eastern Approach Road
Junction until all the co-owners included in
this block shall submit an application for one
combined building to be erected on the whole
plot or until after the Responsible Authority
will proceed with expropriation and indemni-
fication of those owners whose properties were
injurious affected by this scheme.

The areas hatched black on the plan
shall be classed as "Reconstruction Area" and
shall be subject to the provisions quoted
under Part No. 4 of the Haifa Outline Town
Planning Scheme.

Sites for a Public Building.

Only a public building shall be
erected on the plot coloured yellow, hatched
and edged brown.

Private Open Spaces

All lands coloured light green on the plan and edged dark green shall be private open spaces and no development shall take place thereon without the approval of the District Building & Town Planning Commission.

No portion of a private open space shall be added to the curtilage of any building plot to increase its area to the required curtilage or to increase its built up area over the allowed percentage.

Public Open Spaces.

All lands coloured dark green shall remain public open spaces.

All lands coloured light green and hatched dark green on the plan shall be public open spaces.

All lands so coloured which have not yet been acquired by the Municipal Corporation of Haifa, shall, subject to the provisions of the Haifa Outline Town Planning Scheme, be subject to compulsory purchase, provided always:-

- i) That this provision shall not preclude the acquisition of such land by agreement with affected owners or persons.
- ii) All public open spaces shall after expropriation be maintained by the Municipal Corporation of Haifa.
- iii) The cost of construction of these open spaces shall be borne, as hereafter provided, by the owners of the land contained in the scheme, the Municipal Corporation of Haifa participating in the cost of construction to the extent of 25% thereof. Provided that if the owners desire to carry out any such works before the Municipal Corporation is prepared to participate they shall obtain the prior authorization in writing of the Municipal Corporation and shall bear the whole cost.
- iv) The cost of these open spaces shall be apportioned between the owners of the land comprised in the scheme in proportion to the area owned by them provided that the owner of land abutting on the open space shall pay a double share.
- v) No owner shall be called upon to pay his share before he has built upon his land or before the majority of the owners affected have built upon their plots, whichever shall first occur.

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V. AMENITIES

Shops. In residential Districts shops may be opened only on those plots indicated on the plan by a violet line.

Roads. The Owners of areas included in this scheme, shall pay for the construction of all roads, which shall be carried out in accordance with the Standard Municipal Specifications and to a full carriageway width, at any time after enactment of the scheme, and before any building is allowed to be erected on abutting plots. The Haifa Municipal Corporation may compel landowners to pay for the construction of roads whether their plots have been built upon or not.
