Purpose of the Scheme: To' provide for an orderly lay-out of the land destined for an agricultural workers' camp.

Provisions:

All the provisions of the Lydda District Regional Outline Town Planning Scheme and any amendments and additions there to shall apply to this scheme.

ZONES:

Agricultural Zone.

Permissible Building percentage:

The total built up area of the buildings shall not exceed 15% of the net area of one plot

±50 SQ.M.for Farm Buildings.

BUILDING LINES:

Minimum front set-back shall not be less than indicated in the plans. Minimum side distance between the buildings shall no be less than

10 metres.

OPEN SPACES:

All lands coloured green and edged dark green on the plan shall be kept as private open spaces for the use of the settlers. No buildings shall be erected on these plots without the

approval of the District Commission.

ROADS: H.

The width of all roads and the proposed building

lines shall be as indicated on the plan.

Corners of road junctions shall be constructed in such a manner that ample visibility is obtained by applying accepted standards.

Roads in this Scheme are private roads, the cost of construction to be borne by the settlers.

I. CENTRAL AMENITIES:

a) Sewerage

By ground infiltration and by natural drainage channels.

b) Sanitary Accommodations

Showers and lavatories shall be accommodated in separate buildings as approved by the Public Health Department.

c) Water Supply

From a local water supply approved by the

Public Health Department.

d) General Health:

The tenants shall comply with the requirements

of the Public Health Department as to carrying out anti-malaria measures which may be necessary on these lands.

J. SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

No amendment to the conditions and regulations of this scheme shall be legal unless authorised in writing by the Lydda District Building and Town Planning Commission.
